This filing is made to revise rates of the rural CLECs that are permitted to tariff switched access rates up to the highest rate band in the NECA tariff as stated in F.C.C.'s Eighth Report and Order CC Docket No. 96-262.

Also, according to FCC Order 19-66 released July 12, 2019, the CLECs in Price-Cap areas are de-tariffing their Business Data Services (BDS) as required by August 1, 2020 in this filing. These CLECs have implemented customer contracts with established rates, terms, and conditions.
