In compliance with the Communications Act of 1934, attached for filing please find the proposed revisions to pages 1 and 41 of the Interstate Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 of Mid-Maine Telplus LLC ("MMTP"), which carries a proposed effective date of September 8, 2020.

This filing is made pursuant to the Federal Communications Commission's Business Data Services (BDS) Order, which requires CLECs to de-tariff all packet based BDS services, TDM transport, and TDM BDS service end user channel terminations in competitive counties. MMTP already billed its BDS on an individual case basis, therefore, the revisions are administrative and do not have an impact on MMTP's process or billing.
