The accompanying tariff material issued by GTC, Inc. ("GTC") as Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, effective January 1, 2000, is being electronically filed in compliance with the requirements of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended.

This tariff filing is in response to the Access Charge Reform Proceeding in CC Docket 96-262, et.al., where telephone companies were instructed to reduce cost allocations to the residual transport category over a three-year period. This filing represents the third phase of the transition.

GTC is a Subset 3 carrier with 50,000 or fewer access lines and, therefore, makes this filing pursuant to Section 61.39 of the Rules.

As required by Section 61.32(b) of the Rules, the filing fee of Six Hundred and Thirty Dollars (\$630.00) along with the FCC Form 159 will be overnighted on the day of filing to the FCC office in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania.
