B. Long Distance Access Fee

Telecommunications services provided to Customers by the Company are also subject to a monthly charge imposed by the Company and payable by the Customer. The charge, noted on the Customer's bill as a Long Distance Access Fee, shall be added to each long distance line and is calculated as follows:

Business Customers	\$ 6.00 per line per month	(I)
Centrex	\$ 6.00 per line per month	(I)
ISDN PRI	\$30.00 per interface* per month	(I)
Residential Customers	\$ 6.00 per line per month	

The line determination is based on available Company and/or LEC-provided information. Where line charges cannot be determined by the underlying carrier, all line charges are \$6.00. (I)

The Long Distance Access Fee helps to cover costs including the cost of access charges and fees that Local Exchange Carriers assess on interexchange carriers. This is a Company surcharge, not a tax, is not mandated by the FCC, and is subject to change.

The Long Distance Access Fee will be billed at 50% of the applicable rate when the line is seasonally suspended.

* The ISDN PRI charge is per pipe, not per channel.
