In compliance with the Communications Act of 1934, attached for filing please find the proposed revisions to pages 1 and 41 of the Interstate Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 of Mid-Maine Telplus LLC ("MMTP"), which carries a proposed effective date of July 1, 2021.

This filing is made pursuant to the Federal Communication Commission's 2020 8YY Access Charge Reform Order ("Order"), which includes transitioning 8YY end office originating charges to bill-and-keep over approximately three years and creating a single charge for 8YY tandem switching and transport services. In addition, changes were made to update references to the FairPoint Companies' Tariff FCC No. 1 to Consolidated Communications of Northern New England Company, LLC FCC Access Tariff No. 7.
