These temporary discounts are limited to a customer or a customer's subscriber household with a student in grades K-12 or a technical high school equivalent program who are categorically eligible for a reduced cost or free lunch through the National School Lunch Program. The Telephone Company must verify the customer or customer's subscriber household contains a qualifying student by obtaining documentation regarding reduced cost or free lunch eligibility.

ADSL and SDSL Voice-Data Access Service at downstream speeds less than 1 Mbps or greater than 100 Mbps are excluded from these promotions.

The Access Order Charge and non-recurring installation charge are waived for these promotional offerings. No minimum service periods or term commitment penalties apply.

Prior to the end of the promotional period, the Telephone Company will provide reasonable notification to the customer of the option to continue the upgraded or new ADSL/SDSL Voice-Data service beyond the promotional period at the non-discounted monthly rates.
