The accompanying tariff material issued on behalf of Northwest Fiber, LLC d/b/a ZiPLY Fiber Telephone Companies ("ZiPLY") bearing TARIFF FCC No. 1, 2, & 3 Access Service is sent to you for filing, in compliance with the requirements of the Communication Act of 1934, as amended. This filing, to become effective October 1, 2022, on 15 days' notice under the Commission's streamlined tariff procedures, consists of tariff pages as indicated on the following check sheets:

This filing proposes tariff revisions to implement exogenous cost adjustments to reflect changes in the Telecommunications Relay Service ("TRS") carrier contribution factor, the North American Numbering Plan Administration ("NANPA") contribution factor, and the annual regulatory fee for Interstate Telecommunications Service Providers ("ITSP"). A Description and Justification, supporting exhibits, and a certification are provided as part of this submission.

ZiPLY has requested under separate cover that certain information contained in its filing be kept confidential and not disclosed to the public. As explained in that separate filing, the information is “confidential business information,” and public disclosure would cause substantial harm to the competitive position of the company. ZiPLY, therefore, respectfully requests that the Commission withhold that information from public disclosure, pursuant to Section 552(b)(4) of the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(4), Sections 0.457(d)(2) and 0.459(b) of the Commission’s Rules, 47 C.F.R. §§ 0.457(d)(2), 0.459(b) (2021), and *In the Matter of Implementation of Section 402(b)(1)(A) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996*, CC Docket No. 96-187, Report and Order, 12 FCC Rcd 2170 (1997) (“Tariff Streamlining Order”).

This filing also proposes tariff revisions to reflect the change in the Federal Universal Service Fund Contribution Factor for the 4th Quarter of 2022, pursuant to the Commission’s Public Notice, “Proposed Fourth Quarter 2022 Universal Service Contribution Factor, CC Docket No. 96-45,” DA 22-946 (rel. Sept. 13, 2022). Specifically, ZiPLY proposes to decrease its charge to recover its Federal Universal Service Fund contributions to reflect the change in the FCC’s factor from 33.0% to 28.9%, effective October 1, 2022.

This filing has been submitted electronically through the Commission’s Electronic Tariff Filing System (“ETFS”), in accordance with Section 61.13(b) of the Commission’s rules and regulations. 47 C.F.R. § 61.13(b) (2021). The appropriate filing fee (\$930.00; fee type code “CQK”) is being submitted electronically today, in accordance with Section 61.14(b) of the Commission’s rules. *Id.* at § 61.14(b).
