6.3 Federal Universal Service Fund ("FUSF")

In connection with the FCC's Universal Service Orders, the Company is required to contribute to the Federal Universal Service Fund ("FUSF") on all retail revenues derived from its provisioning of Interstate telecommunications and interconnected VoIP services. The Company will recover its FUSF obligations by imposing FUSF on all retail charges for Interstate and International telecommunications and interconnected VoIP services. This surcharge is in addition to standard usage charges and any applicable service charges and surcharges associated with the Company's service. The Company's Universal Service rate will match the relevant quarterly Universal Service Contribution Factor approved by the FCC rounded up to the nearest tenth of a percent. 6.5 End User Common Line Charge (“EUCL”)

The Company recovers some of the costs of its facilities through a monthly charge called the End User Common Line Charge (“EUCL”). The EUCL is a monthly, flat-rated charge assessed to end users for each local exchange service.
