With this filing, Nevada Bell Telephone Company (NBTC) proposes to grandfather certain term lengths and commitment periods associated with various plans for legacy TDM-based services. Two and three-year DS1 Term Payment Plans (DS1 TPP); and three-year DS3 High Capacity Service Payment Plans will no longer be available. Customers may not establish new, renew, extend, or convert circuits for the grandfathered term plans nor select any grandfathered term plans when committing any service to a new term plan. For DS1 TPP, one-year and month-to-month rates will continue to be available. For DS3 High Capacity Service Plans, one-year and monthly extension rates will continue to be available.

Supporting information discussed under Section 61.49 of the Commission's Rules, to the extent applicable, is included with this filing in the attached Description and Justification.

In accordance with Section 61.14, this transmittal letter and associated attachments are being filed electronically today via the Federal Communications Commission's Electronic Tariffing System (ETFS) in compliance with the electronic filing procedures.
