With this filing Hawaiian Telcom, Inc. is increasing the First Quarter 2023 Universal Service Fund (USF) Contribution Factor in Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 and Tariff F.C.C. No. 2, pursuant to Public Notice, DA 22-1286, CC Docket No. 96-45, released December 9, 2022.

With this filing, HTI is also removing tariff references to the Mokapu wire center from the Company’s Wire Center Zone Assignments for the provisioning of facilities for interstate access.

Pursuant to notification requirements in 47 CFR §51.325 - §51.335, on August 14, 2020 HTI submitted a Certification of Short Term Public Notice of Network Change (“Notice”) to advise the Federal Communications Commission that the Mokapu Central Office (“CO”) would be collapsed and existing switching equipment would be decommissioned and replaced by a pad mounted cabinet equipped with broadband loop carrier and other fiber terminal equipment to continue to provide voice, high speed internet, and dedicated circuit services to existing end users. HTI also served the Notice via email to each known provider of competitive local exchange service that interconnects directly with HTI at the Mokapu CO and posted the Notice on the Company’s website.

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Due to the completion of all work activities involved with the decommissioning of the Mokapu CO, including the migration of services rendered to existing customers, the Company is removing references to the Mokapu wire center and its associated CLLItm. There is no service impact to existing customers resulting from these changes.

This transmittal letter and associated attachments are being filed electronically today via the Federal Communications Commission's Electronic Tariff Filing System (ETFS). Payment in the amount of \$930.00 has been electronically transmitted to the U.S. Bank in St. Louis, Missouri in accordance with the fee program procedures.
