Effective June 1, 2024, Nevada Bell Telephone Company, LLC (NBTC) grandfathered Shared Use arrangements in Transmittal No. 2. On July 17, 2024, NBTC filed Transmittal No. 4 to allow customers to create new Shared Use arrangements, and moves, adds, and make changes to new and existing arrangements effective August 1, 2024. As of that date, all Shared Use arrangements would be rated as Special Access Service, regardless of whether the individual channels are Special Access, Switched Access, or any other type of Service. NBTC would no longer apply rate adjustments for Shared Use arrangements.

In this filing, NBTC proposes to withdraw material filed under Transmittal No. 2, and Transmittal No. 4 to address issues that were subsequently identified after the initial filing.


