With this filing, Nevada is implementing the Payphone Use Charge in the Nevada Interstate IntraLATA Message Telecommunications Service Tariff F.C.C. No. 2. The Payphone Use Charge is a surcharge rate element, which will apply to all completed non-sent paid (alternately billed) calls that originate from payphones. The charge is a cost recovery mechanism that permits the Local Exchange Carrier to recover the cost of per-call compensation to Payphone Service Providers, from the end user.

Supporting information discussed under Section 61.38 of the Commission's Rules, to the extent applicable, is included with this filing.
