Dear Ms. Salas:

Pursuant to Section 61.15(f) of the Commission's Rules, transmitted herewith please find Supplement 1 to Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 of Townes Telecommunications, Inc. ("Townes"), canceling the tariff in its entirety as of July 1, 2000.

Effective July 1, 2000, each of the Townes affiliates and subsidiaries which previously were issuing carriers in Townes Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 will henceforth be issuing carriers in National Exchange Carrier Association ("NECA") Tariff F.C.C. No. 5. Pursuant to Section 61.87 of the Commission's Rules, Townes is therefore canceling its own tariff.

As required by Section 61.32 of the Rules, the original of this transmittal letter, plus the Commission's filing fee of six hundred and thirty dollars (\$630.00) for tariff filings, is being filed this date with the Mellon Bank in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania.
