3.3.1 Description

(T)

Business/Residence Line 800 Service provides for the termination of inbound toll-free 800 calls over nondedicated business and residence one-party lines. Business/Residence Line 800 Service is provided as an add-on to intrastate intraMarket Area Business/Residence Line 800 Services. Rates applicable to Business/Residence Line 800 traffic originating from stations within a Market Area to a station associated with an 800 termination point within the same Market Area, but within a different state, are shown in 3.3.3. Business/Residence Line 800 Services are provided between rate centers within the Market Areas described in 3.1.(B)(1).

3.3.2 Rate Application

(T)

- (A) Chargeable time for Business/Residence Line 800 Service calls is determined in the manner described in 2.10.4 for LDMTS calls.
- (B) All messages completed in one billing period through Business/Residence Line 800 Service will be bulk billed a minimum of 30 seconds per message.
- (C) The minimum service period for Business/Residence Line 800 Service is one month.
- (D) Usage is subject to a Minimum Average Time Requirement (MATR) of 30 seconds per completed call. If the average duration per call during each billing cycle is less than 30 seconds, billing will be based on an average duration of 30 seconds per call.
- (E) The monthly usage charges for Business/Residence Line 800 Service are determined as follows:
 - (1) Determine the total number of calls for each Business/Residence Line 800 Service number.
 - (2) Determine the equivalent hours rounded to the nearest tenth used by applying the MATR as described in (D).
 - (3) Determine total actual hours used, rounded to the nearest tenth of one hour.
 - (4) Determine the chargeable hours which is the greater of (2) or (3).
 - (5) Multiply the chargeable hours by the usage charge shown in 3.3.3, rounded to (T) the next highest cent.

3.4 Public Land Mobile Radiotelephone Service

3.4.1 Through Base Stations of The Telephone Company

(A) Application

(1) Two-way communication service is furnished through radiotelephone Base Stations, listed in (C)(3) following, within a Market Area between a vehicle and a point located outside the land mobile service area associated with such Base Station, between two vehicles served through Base Stations having different rate centers or between a vehicle served through a Base Station and a ship or aircraft served through an other land radiotelephone station.

(2) Public Land Mobile Service is available to vehicles equipped for this service when within range of a Base Station through which such service is furnished. Service is furnished subject to transmission, atmospheric and like limitations.

This service is also available through a Base Station, between a point or a vehicle and another station, hereinafter called an "Other Station" which is authorized by the Federal Communications Commission to communicate with the Base Station, or between two "Other Stations" so authorized.

In the application of regulations and rates, stations other than vehicles which are authorized by the Federal Communications Commission to communicate with a Base Station are considered as vehicles.

(3) The services offered are those referred to in (B)(1) and in (B)(2) following.

(B) Mileage Measurements - Rate Determination

(1) Rates for service as set forth in (a) through (b) following are based on airline mileage between rate centers or mileage rate bands. Obtain V-H coordinates for Base Station rate centers by reference to AT&T's Tariff FCC No. 10.
