

ACCESS SERVICE

12. Specialized Service Or Arrangements

12.1 General

Specialized Service or Arrangements may be provided by the Telephone Company, at the request of a customer, on an individual case basis if such service or arrangements meet the following criteria.

- 12.1.1 The requested service or arrangements are not offered under other sections of this tariff.
- 12.1.2 The facilities utilized to provide the requested service or arrangements are of a type normally used by the Telephone Company in furnishing its other services.
- 12.1.3 The requested service or arrangements are provided within a LATA.
- 12.1.4 The requested service or arrangements are compatible with other Telephone Company services, facilities, and its engineering and maintenance practices.
- 12.1.5 This offering is subject to the availability of the necessary Telephone Company personnel and capital resources.

12.2 Move Charges

- 12.2.1 When service without a maximum termination liability charge associated with it is moved to a different building, the nonrecurring charge applies; when moved to a new location in the same building, a charge of one-half the nonrecurring charge applies.

12. Specialized Service Or Arrangements (Cont'd)12.1 Move Charges (Cont'd)

12.2.2 When service with a maximum termination liability charge associated with it is moved and is reinstalled at a new location, the customer may elect:

- To pay the unexpired portion of the maximum termination liability charge for the service, if any, with the application of a nonrecurring charge and the establishment of a new maximum termination liability charge for such service at the new location, or
- To continue service subject to the unexpired portion of the maximum termination liability charge, if any, and pay the estimated costs of moving such service, provided that the customer requests these charges be quoted prior to ordering the service move. Charges for moving such service will be based on estimated costs attributable to the move.

Move charges include the estimated costs of removal, restoration of services or facilities necessitated by the move, transportation, storage, reinstallation, engineering, labor, supervision, materials, administration, and any other specific items of cost directly attributable to the move.

Through the dates as specified following, certain ICB Case customers may either convert their service(s) to general tariff rates, or continue their service(s) under ICB contract, whereupon general tariff rates will apply. In either case, neither minimum service period charges nor termination liability charges will apply. Should the customer request a Service Discount Plan, as set forth in 7.4.10 preceding, for some or all services converted to general tariff rates, the period of time the service(s) existed under the ICB contract may be applied to the appropriate Service Discount Plan.

Combine the customer's NYNEX Enterprise Services with certain functionality available through Network Reconfiguration Service (NRS) as described below. The specialized service consists of a minimum of 252 DS0 Services including NYNEX Enterprise DS0 Standard and Prime Services and, where facilities do not permit the provision of NES DS0, DIGIPATH digital service II (DDS II) channels which are groomed up to DS1 Services at selected Telephone Company Hubs. These Hubs are within the same wire center and perform both NYNEX Enterprise Service and NRS functions. The groomed DS1 Services provide Mid-link connections between the NES and NRS Hubs located within the same wire center. These Mid-links terminate on NRS 1.544 Mbps Network Access Ports on the digital cross-connect systems in order to provide the NRS functionality.

This specialized service will enable the customer to utilize NRS technology to connect, or reconfigure, the individual DS0s riding channels of the groomed DS1 Services. The customer will utilize a dial-up termination to access the NRS network controller. The network controller will validate the customer's commands and forward the customer's instructions to the digital cross-connect systems to effect the reconfiguration.

The rates and charges which apply for this specialized service are the existing applicable rates and charges associated with the services which comprise the specialized arrangement. Section 31.7.12 following specifies the rates and charges for the DDS II portion of the specialized service. Section 31.7.15 following specifies the rates and charges associated with the NYNEX Enterprise Service portion of the specialized service. Section 31.19 following specifies the rates and charges associated with the NRS Network Access ports and dial-up access to the NRS Network Controller. The DS1 Mid-links between the NRS and NES Hubs in the same wire center are provided at no charge to the Customer.

This specialized service is subject to all applicable regulations pertaining to NYNEX Enterprise Services, DDS II and Network Reconfiguration Service as set forth in other sections of this tariff.
