ACCESS SERVICE**1. Application of Tariff**

- 1.1 This tariff contains regulations, rates and charges applicable to the provision of Switched Access, Special Access, and other miscellaneous services, hereinafter referred to collectively as service(s). These services are provided to customers by Dekalb Telephone Cooperative, Inc., hereinafter referred to as the Telephone Company. This tariff also contains Access Ordering regulations and charges that are applicable when these services are ordered or modified by the customer. Pursuant to the Commission's Rules at Sections 69.4(c), 69.5(d), 69.104(1), 69.116, 69.117, 69.603(c), and 69.603(d), regulations concerning administration and billing of Lifeline Assistance and Universal Service Fund, rates and charges for these carrier's carrier elements are contained in Section 8 herein. The National Exchange Carrier Association, Inc. will bill and collect all Lifeline Assistance and Universal Service Fund Charges on behalf of the Telephone Company.
- 1.2 The provision of such service by the Telephone Company as set forth in this tariff does not constitute a joint undertaking with the Customer for the furnishing of any service.
