Re: Qwest Petition for Pricing Flexibility for Special Access and Dedicated Transport Services, CCB/CPD File No. 02-01

Dear Ms. Salas:

On December 31, 2001, Qwest Corporation ("Qwest") filed the above-captioned Petition for Pricing Flexibility.¹ Qwest submits this ex parte letter to avoid any possible confusion regarding the collocation arrangements that Qwest relies on in its Petition.

Pursuant to section 1.774(e) of the Commission's rules, Qwest provided to each party upon which it relies in its Petition the collocation information about that party that Qwest intended to include in the Petition.² Shortly before it filed the Petition, and subsequent to its mailing of the collocation information to the respective collocators, Qwest performed a final verification of the collocation information included in the Petition. As a result of this verification, Qwest omitted from its Petition a total of seven collocation arrangements in the following six wire centers:

PHNXAZSE (Phoenix-Southeast, AZ)
SLKCUTSO (Salt Lake City-South, UT)
SLKCUTWE (Salt Lake City-West, UT)
MDVAUTMA (Midvale, UT)
BLLVWAGL (Bellview-Glencourt, WA)
STTLWACH (Seattle-Cherry, WA)

In the attached list, Qwest identifies the name of the collocator for each collocation arrangement omitted from the Petition as a result of Qwest's final verification of collocation information.³
