The accompanying tariff Supplement No. 1 issued by James Valley Cooperative Telephone Company (JVCTC) (FRN #0005-0972-71), and bearing F.C.C. No. 1, is sent to you for filing in compliance with the Communications Act of 1934, as amended.

In response to the Commission's Order (In the Matter of December 17, 2001 MAG Access Charge Tariff Filings), DA 01-3023, released December 31, 2001, this filing advances the effective date of tariff revisions under Transmittal No. 3 from January 1, 2002 to December 31, 2001, and then suspends the effective date of those revisions for a period of one day until January 1, 2002.
