Dear Ms. Salas;

Yesterday, Julia Wentz, Christopher T. Shenk (Sidley, Austin, Brown and Wood) and I met with Judith Nitsche, Deena Shetler, Steve Morris, Shannon Lipp, Steve Funkhouser and Jim Lichford. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss AT&T's Petition and the comments and reply comments filed by all parties in the above mentioned proceeding. The attached diagrams were used as a basis for the discussion. AT&T described the situations in which these types of disputes had occurred and emphasized the severe impact these disputes had on customers. In addition, AT&T reiterated that the LECs are required by law to provide access facilities up to the POI designated by the IXC and that the FCC simply needed to reaffirm that law.

The positions expressed by AT&T were consistent with those expressed in AT&T's filed petition and reply comments.

Consistent with the Commission rules, I am filing one electronic copy of this notice and request that you place it in the record of the proceedings.

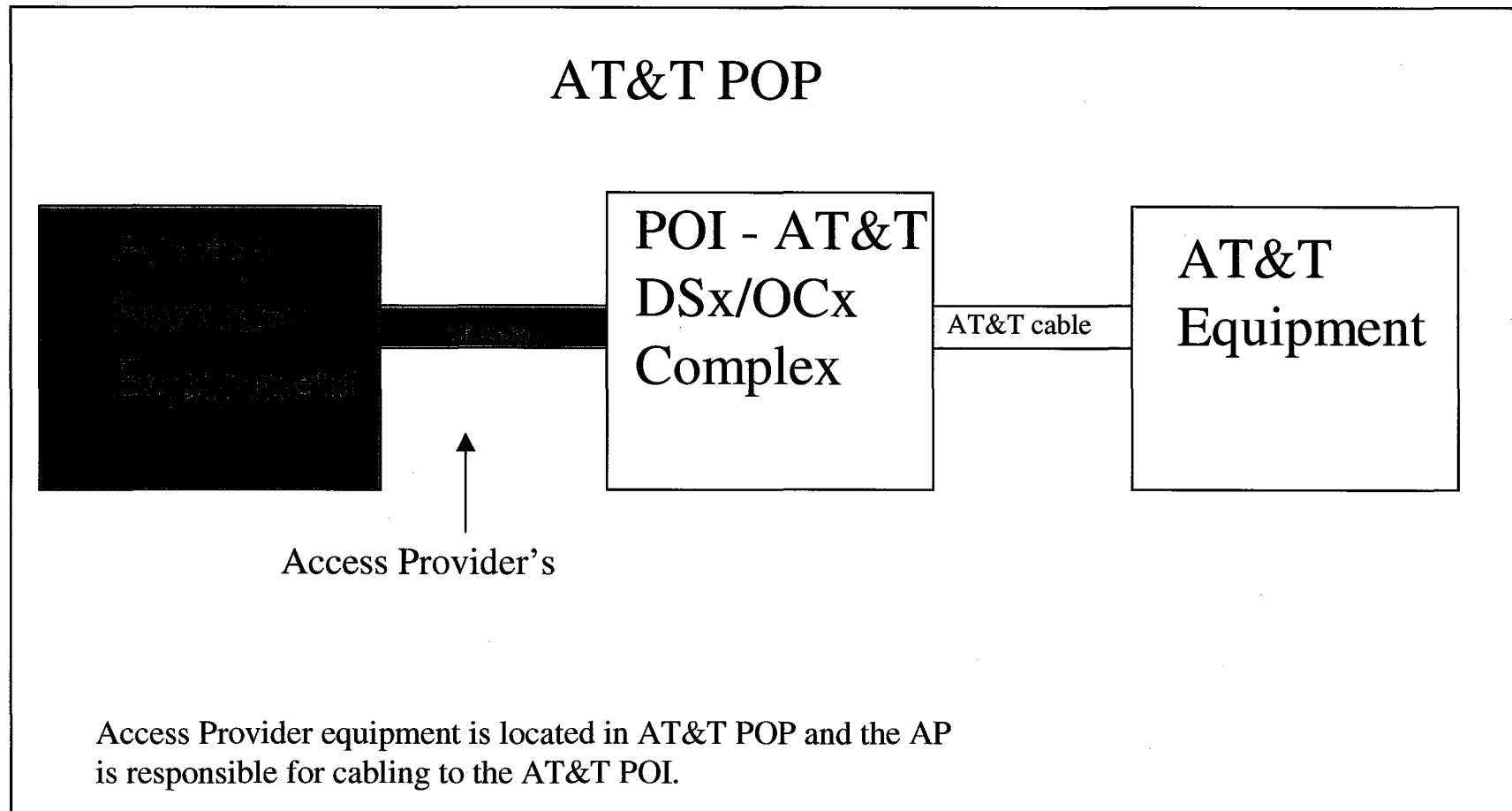

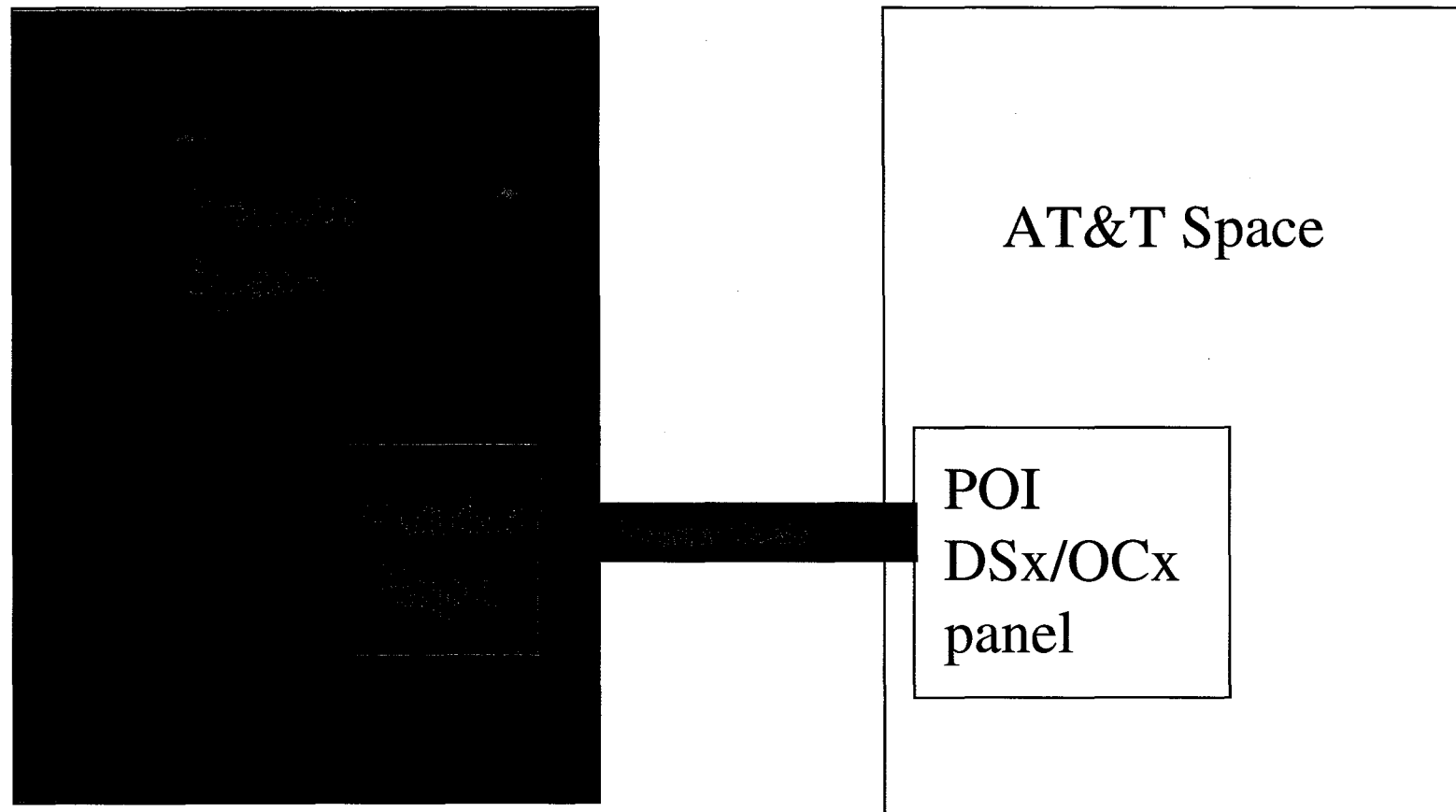
