This filing is being made on one day's notice and establishes regulations, rates and charges for the provision of interstate switched dedicated and special access services in additional Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSAs) where Sprint LTC has been granted Phase II pricing flexibility in accordance with subpart H of the Commission's Part 69 rules:¹ Sprint LTC's new pricing flexibility MSAs include Fayetteville, North Carolina and York, Pennsylvania.

Description and Justification and a Tariff Review Plan detailing the impact of the removal of these services from the switched and special access price cap baskets is provided as a part of this filing in compliance with the Commission's pricing flexibility requirements.
