Application is hereby made on behalf of Qwest Corporation (Qwest) FRN 0003-7467-57 (Concurring Carriers, The Malheur Home Telephone Company FRN 0003-7467-65 and El Paso County Telephone Company FRN 0004-3212-46), for Special Permission to waive the requirements of Sections 61.58 and 61.59 of the Commission's rules.

Qwest intends to make a filing to modify tariff material associated with Transmittal No. 140, specifically language for Termination Liability and Waiver policy associated with GeoMax, which was filed September 16, 2002 and has an effective date of October 1, 2002.
