The first part of this filing is being made by Qwest in its Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, Section 13, Miscellaneous Services, to add a new product, Managed Long Distance (MLD). MLD is a call management service that provides an interexchange carrier the capability to offer limited direct dialed long distance service to end users who would otherwise be toll restricted or required to pay a long distance security deposit. Calls are routed through the MLD platform for monitoring, timing and voice prompts and subsequently routed to the interexchange carrier's network.
