BELLSOUTH® REMOTE ACCESS SERVICE REGULATIONS REVISION  
DESCRIPTION AND JUSTIFICATION  
TRANSMITTAL NO. 667

With this filing, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. (hereinafter "BellSouth") is revising its Access Services Tariff, F.C.C. No. 1, to revise tariff regulations for BellSouth® Remote Access Service. This filing is scheduled to become effective on October 15, 2002.

BellSouth® Remote Access Service provides for the collection, concentration, signaling and aggregation of a customer's dial-up data traffic into a hub site for transport over dedicated facilities to the customer's designated location. The regulations are being changed in response to newer available technology that allows greater port capacity for this service. On or after October 15, 2002, BellSouth® Remote Access Service initial requests to establish service provide a minimum capacity of 644 one-way ports per dial tone office. Customers in service prior to October 15, 2002, may continue their service with a minimum capacity of 276 one-way ports.

In addition, BellSouth is providing a Single Point of Contact (SPOC) for any Remote Access Service customer subscribing to a minimum of 75,000 ports within the BellSouth region. This SPOC will be utilized for provisioning and maintenance of Remote Access Service.
