The accompanying material is being submitted on behalf of the Sprint local telephone companies (Sprint LTC) in compliance with the requirements of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended.

Sprint LTC endeavors to provide products and services which satisfy customer needs at competitive prices, and continually analyzes multiple aspects of interstate access service, including, but not limited to, bandwidth relationships, demand shifts, cross-over ratios, pricing plans, geographic market variations, and competitive offerings. Based on the results of these analyses, and consistent with the requirements of Sections 61.41 through 61.49 of the Commission's Rules, Sprint LTC filed Transmittal No. 206 proposing within-band, within-cap rate adjustments for special access services in all Sprint LTC jurisdictions, except Nevada and Northwest (Oregon and Washington). Within-band, within-cap adjustments are not required for Nevada, since Sprint LTC was granted pricing flexibility the metropolitan statistical areas comprising its entire Nevada jurisdiction. Similarly, Sprint LTC's analyses of access service relationships in the Northwest jurisdiction indicate that price cap adjustments are not warranted at this time.

Based on recent discussions with the Wireline Competition Bureau staff, Sprint LTC is providing amended Description and Justification material in support of Transmittal No. 206, along with an additional exhibit summarizing the individual rate elements being adjusted. It should be noted that Sprint LTC notified affected customers of the rate adjustments included in Transmittal No. 206 on or before the date of filing, and Sprint LTC will also notify affected customers of the proposed amendment.

In accordance with the requirements of Section 61.21(a)(3) of the Commission's Rules, the FCC Registration Number (FRN) for Sprint is 0003-7619-39. Sprint LTC is filing this transmittal on behalf of issuing carriers with the following FRNs:
