The accompanying tariff material, issued by SBC Advanced Solutions, Inc. (ASI) and bearing Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, is being submitted on not less than three day's notice in compliance with Section 61.58 (a)(3) of the Commission's rules and the requirements of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended.

On September 23, 2002 in Transmittal 11, ASI made a filing in Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 to introduce restructured Asynchronous Transfer Mode (ATM) and Frame Relay Services and create vintage service sections for the existing ATM and Frame Relay Services established pursuant to sections 4.1 through 4.4 and 5.1 through 5.4 of the tariff, respectively. The filing also made modifications to various other sections of the tariff.


This filing will defer, by Supplement, the effective date of this material from October 8 to October 22, 2002.
