Under authority of Special Permission No. 02-126, this filing is being made by Qwest in its Tariff F.C.C. No.1 to withdraw tariff material associated with Transmittal No. 142, specifically Managed Long Distance (MLD) Service, which was filed September 27, 2002 and has an effective date of October 12, 2002. MLD is a call management service that provides an IC the capability to offer its end user limited 1+ direct dialed long distance calling. Qwest is withdrawing the tariff material associated with MLD since, upon further review, it has been determined that this offerings does not need to be tariffed. This filing is being made on not less than one day's notice.

Supporting information discussed under Sections 61.38 and 61.49 of the Commission's Rules is not required to make this filing.
