Citizens Telecommunications Companies ("Citizens") submits herewith its Description and Justification ("D&J") in support of changes to its Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 filed under Transmittal No. 127, pursuant to sections 61.41 through 61.49 of the Commission's rules and relevant Commission orders.

In this Transmittal, Citizens changes terms, conditions, and rates for some of its ADSL Channel service offerings.

As technology advances, Citizens finds that it is able to provide higher speed ADSL service in some areas than in others. Citizens plans to increase the peak downstream speed of its ADSL Channel, Class R2 service from 384 Kbps to 1.0 Mbps throughout its network; however, it will not be possible to make this increase simultaneously in all places.

Accordingly, Citizens is changing the peak downstream speed for this service from 384 Kbps to a range from 384 Kbps to 1.0 Mbps. The actual peak speed offered will be dependent on the equipment and facilities Citizens has available in the customer's area.
