This filing is being made on 15 days' notice under the Federal Communications Commission's streamlined filing procedures and proposes the following revisions:

- (1) Switched dedicated rate adjustments in the Orlando and Tallahassee, Florida; Fayetteville, Greenville, Hickory and Rocky Mount, North Carolina; Las Vegas, Nevada; and Charlottesville, Virginia metropolitan statistical areas (MSAs) and special access rate adjustments in the Orlando and Tallahassee, Florida; Fayetteville, Greenville, Hickory and Rocky Mount, North Carolina; Las Vegas, Nevada; York, Pennsylvania; and Charlottesville, Virginia MSAs where pricing flexibility has been granted pursuant to Subpart H of Part 69 of the Commission's rules;
- (2) Addition of rates and regulations expanding the availability of Temporary Suspension of Service to DSL customers subscribing to Options II, III, IV and VI;
- (3) Addition of tariff language identifying the DSL wire centers comprising Virginia Region 1 and Virginia Region 2; and

- (4) Minor tariff language changes designed to clarify the provision of interstate access services.


