Dear Ms. Dortch:

Pursuant to Sections 61.152 and 61.153 of the Commission's rules, SBC Advanced Solutions, Inc. (ASI) respectfully requests special permission to file revisions to its Tariff F.C.C. No. 1. ASI requests waivers of Sections 61.58 and 61.59 of the Commission's rules.

On September 23, 2002 in Transmittal No. 11, ASI made a filing in Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 to introduce restructured Asynchronous Transfer Mode (ATM) and Frame Relay Services and create vintage service sections for the existing ATM and Frame Relay Services established pursuant to sections 4.1 through 4.4 and 5.1 through 5.4 of the tariff, respectively. The filing also made modifications to various other sections of the tariff.

On October 4, 2002 in Transmittal No. 12, ASI made a filing, by Supplement, to defer the effective date of this material from October 8, 2002 to October 22, 2002.

On October 18, 2002 in Transmittal No. 13, ASI made a filing, by Supplement, to again defer the effective date of this material from October 22, 2002 to October 29, 2002.

With this filing ASI seeks, at Staff's request, a waiver of Section 61.58 to further defer the effective date of this material from October 29, 2002 to November 19, 2002. It is ASI's understanding that the extension is requested for the sole purpose of providing notice to customers of the pendency of the tariff filing. It is ASI's further understanding that the extension is not for the purpose of soliciting additional comments on the tariff filing.


A waiver of Section 61.59 is requested to permit revisions to tariff material that has not yet become effective.
