The accompanying tariff material, issued by SBC Advanced Solutions, Inc. (ASI) and bearing Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, is sent to you for filing in compliance with the requirements of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended.

With this filing ASI proposes to defer the effective date of the tariff material contained in Transmittal No. 11 from October 29, 2002 to November 19, 2002. In Transmittal No. 11, ASI introduced restructured Asynchronous Transfer Mode (ATM) and Frame Relay Services and created vintage service sections for the existing ATM and Frame Relay Services established pursuant to sections 4.1 through 4.4 and 5.1 through 5.4 of the tariff, respectively. The filing also made modifications to various other sections of the tariff.


