Application is hereby made by BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. (hereinafter BellSouth), for Special Permission to waive Sections 61.58 and 61.59 of the Commission's Rules in order to withdraw without becoming effective Transmittal No. 674.

On November 15, 2002 in Transmittal 674, BellSouth made a filing in Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, Section 9 to reduce rates, terms and usage commitments for certain existing BellSouth Optional DA Calling Plan 1 Savings Plan options and to add a new volume/term option to the plan.

With this application, BellSouth wishes to withdraw Transmittal 674 pursuant to discussions with various customers and with the Commission's Staff. Illustrative tariff pages are attached for your review.

A waiver of Section 61.58 is requested to permit the revision of tariff material to become effective on not less than 1 day's notice. A waiver of Section 61.59 is requested to permit revisions to tariff material that has not yet become effective.


