The accompanying tariff material, issued by SBC Advanced Solutions, Inc. (ASI) and bearing Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, issued under Special Permission No. 02-146 of the F.C.C., is being submitted in compliance with the requirements of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended.

With this filing ASI proposes the following revisions to its Tariff F.C.C. No. 1:

- (1) Rate reductions for Wholesale DSL Transport and Remote LAN DSL Transport;
- (2) The introduction of Federal Universal Service Fund (FUSF) surcharges to explicitly recover Universal Service Fund (USF) contributions for Wholesale DSL Transport, Remote LAN DSL Transport, Frame Relay Service and Asynchronous Transfer Mode (ATM) Service; and
- (3) Clarify the duration of a Wholesale DSL Transport Volume Discount Plan (DSL-VDP) contract year and add language to specify that DSL-VDP termination charges will not apply if Customer terminates a DSL Transport Service Arrangement and the disconnect completion date is within 14 calendar days after the service order completion date.


