The Verizon Telephone Companies (Verizon) hereby apply for Special Permission for a waiver of Section 61.74 of the Commission's Rules.

Verizon plans to introduce Local Package Basic for customers in New York, Pennsylvania and Virginia. Local Package Basic is an optional service plan for residence Dial Station customers that combines local exchange services, unlimited Intrastate IntraLATA toll usage, and the choice of available Intrastate optional central office service features together with unlimited Interstate IntraLATA service. Verizon must reference its local state tariffs for New York, Pennsylvania and Virginia in order to clarify which Intrastate services are contained in the Local Package Basic plan.

A waiver of Section 61.74 of the Commission's Rules is therefore requested in order to allow reference to Verizon's local intrastate tariffs.

Illustrative tariff pages are included with this application.

This application and associated attachments are being filed electronically today via the Federal Communications Commission's Electronic Tariff Filing System (ETFS).
