This filing is being made on 15 days' notice under the Federal Communications Commission's streamlined filing procedure, and proposes the following revisions to Tariff F.C.C. No. 3:

- 1) Addition of local channel, alternate central office channel, interoffice channel, and internodal channel rates in Section 7.5.15 for use with OC192 Sprint SONET Ring ServiceSM in the state of Nevada.
- 2) Removal of rates and regulations offering access billing information on magnetic tape. This service was previously limited to customers receiving monthly bills or service and equipment records on magnetic tape as of March 3, 2001; however, all such customers have been converted to other media options.
- 3) Removal of two special construction individual case basis filings for the state of Ohio, since it has been determined that the facilities were ordered by the customer for intrastate communications.

- 4) Minor tariff language changes designed to clarify the provision of interstate access service.

Cost support material in accordance with Sections 61.38 and 61.41 through 61.49 of the Commission's Rules is not required for this filing. It should be noted that Sprint LTC notified affected customers of the revisions included in Transmittal No. 210 on or before the date of filing.
