ALLTEL Corporation ("ALLTEL"), pursuant to Sections 61.151 - 61.153 of the Commission's rules, hereby requests Special Permission for waiver of Sections 61.38 and 61.49 of the Commission's rules in order to incorporate Carrier Identification Parameter, Cross-Connect and Digital FT1 services into ALLTEL Telephone Systems (ATS) Tariff F.C.C. No. 3. These services were inadvertently omitted when the original ATS Tariff F.C.C. No. 3 was filed on August 30, 2002. This filing will have no impact to existing customers. Illustrative tariff pages are filed herewith.

A. There Is Good Cause For A Waiver Of Section 61.38 and 61.49 Because ALLTEL Is Not Proposing Any Rate Changes.

Section 61.38 of the Commission's rules requires rate affecting tariff filings to be accompanied by cost data and other supporting information as set forth in the Commission's rules. In the original filing of ATS Tariff F.C.C. No. 3, ALLTEL was granted a waiver of Section 61.38 of the Commission's rules in order to file identical rates which were in effect at the time of the conversion from Verizon to ALLTEL. Because Kentucky ALLTEL is continuing all of Verizon's Kentucky services at the same rates, no purpose would be served by requiring Kentucky ALLTEL to provide all of the supporting information that the Commission has previously relieved ALLTEL from the burden of providing under Sections 61.38 and 61.49.

B. Conclusion

The waiver sought by ALLTEL will enable it to file changes to ATS Tariff F.C.C. No. 3, thereby eliminating duplication and administrative costs for itself and the Commission. These changes will not result in any changes in regulations, rates or charges to any customer. The requested waivers are therefore in the public interest and should be granted.
