Dear Ms. Dortch:

Application is hereby made by TXU Communications Telephone Company, (TXU) (FRN #0003-7319-16), for a limited waiver of Sections 61.58 and 61.59 of the Commission's Rules. A grant of this application will allow TXU to withdraw without becoming effective the filing made on behalf of TXU Communications Telephone Company to add Service Provider Number Portability (SPNP) service pursuant to Transmittal No. 11, on not less than one day's notice.

On February 11, 2003, in Transmittal No. 11, TXU made a filing with the Commission to establish SPNP service. Based on discussions between TXU and the Pricing Policy Division of the Wireline Competition Bureau, issues regarding rate development exist that support withdrawing the filing made under Transmittal No. 11. Based on the foregoing, TXU submits that good cause exists for granting such waiver.

A sample of the appropriate illustrative tariff pages is included with this filing as a separate attachment.
