2000-2 Bank of New York

This specialized arrangement provides the customer with a dedicated Channel Extension Service (CES) network between points within the New York/New Jersey Corridor using dense wave division multiplexing in a ring topology. The architecture consists of fiber rings between customer premises using customer designated network equipment.

The initial network consists of the following channels, each with a maximum bandwidth of 1.25 Gbps:

4 CES channels between 101 Barclay Street and 1 Wall Street, New York, NY
2 CES channels between 101 Barclay Street and Church Street, New York, NY
2 CES channels between 1 Wall Street and Church Street, New York, NY

Additional channels may be provided at any customer location dependent upon the Telephone Company's network capacity, consideration of applicable rates, and upon mutual agreement between the customer and the Telephone Company. Subsequent channels requiring a different rate will be provided upon revision of this tariff.

The Telephone Company will monitor the service arrangement 24 hours a day, seven days a week for trouble isolation and resolution. The customer will have read-only access to the monitoring system.

In addition to the initial service described above, the customer has the option of adding 1.25 Gbps Multiport Facility Arrangement(s) for the balance of the 60 month commitment period at the rates shown below if ordered by December 31, 2003. A 1.25 Gbps Multiport Facility Arrangement utilizes a multiport interface card which allows for up to four channels to be associated with a single wavelength.
