- (S) Pursuant to the Telecommunications Act of 1996, as implemented by the Federal Communications Commission, the Telephone Company is required to pay into a federally mandated Universal Service Fund by means of contribution factors assessed on the Telephone Company's interstate retail end user revenues. The Universal Service Fund provides federally subsidized affordable access to modern telecommunications and information services for schools, libraries and rural health care facilities that meet specific eligibility standards, as well as providing support to subsidize basic telephone service in high cost areas and for low income subscribers.

The Telephone Company recovers its contributions to the Universal Service Fund through the Federal Universal Service Fund (USF) end user charge. The Federal USF end user charge is a percentage surcharge applied to the following interstate charges which give rise to the Telephone Company's contribution obligation.

- End User Common Line Charges
- Presubscribed Interexchange Carrier Charges (PICC)
- Switched Dedicated and Special Access Services
- Digital Subscriber Line (DSL) Services
- Presubscription Change Charges

The Federal USF end user charge will not apply to lifeline services provided to qualifying end users.
