On March 18, 2003, in Transmittal No. 34, Nevada Bell Telephone Company (NBTC), introduced the new enhancement feature of GETS Egress Queuing (EQ) into Section 10 of F.C.C. No. 1. GETS EQ extends the functionality of the existing GETS HPC feature to include two way and Primary Rate ISDN which connects a DMS to a PBX. Transmittal No. 34 is scheduled to become effective on April 2, 2003.

The purpose of this Amended Transmittal letter is to include cost material. The cost material is detailed in the attached Description and Justification.

Supporting information discussed under Sections 61.38 of the Commission's Rules is, to the extent applicable, included with this filing. 
