Application is hereby made by BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc, (hereinafter BellSouth), for Special Permission to waive Section of 61.58 and 61.59 of the Commission's Rules in order to withdraw Transmittal No. 705.

On March 20, 2003, in Transmittal 705, BellSouth made a tariff filing in Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 , revising the F.C.C. Tariff No. 1 to restructure ordering charges associated with service orders and to introduce a charge that would apply when a customer is not ready to a scheduled appointment associated with an expedited order.

With this application, BellSouth wishes to withdraw Transmittal 705 pursuant to discussions with the Commission's Staff. Illustrative tariff pages are attached for your review.

A waiver of Section 61.58 and 61.59 is requested to permit the revision of tariff material to become effective not less than one day's notice and a waiver of Section 61.59 is requested to permit revisions to tariff material that has not yet become effective.
