The Verizon Telephone Companies (Verizon) hereby request special permission for a waiver of Section 61.74 of the Commission's Rules in order to reference Verizon's local exchange tariffs in its Tariff F.C.C. No. 12.

Verizon intends to introduce a new optional calling plan for business customers in the State of New York. Unlimited Local and Toll Usage for Business combines local exchange usage and unlimited Intrastate IntraLATA toll service together with unlimited Interstate IntraLATA toll service. Verizon must reference its local exchange tariffs in order to include local exchange usage and Intrastate IntraLATA usage in this new optional calling plan.

A waiver of Section 61.74 of the Commission's Rules is therefore requested in order to allow reference to Verizon's local exchange tariffs.

Illustrative tariff pages are included with this application.
