Application is hereby made by Nevada Bell Telephone Company (NBTC) for Special Permission to waive Sections 61.58 and 61.59 of the Commission's Rules to withdraw Transmittal No. 39.

On April 4, 2003, in Transmittal No. 39, NBTC proposed changes to Section 7 of its Tariff F.C.C. No. 1. NBTC proposed to introduce a new DS1 Term Payment Plan (DS1 TPP) and to increase the month-to-month DS1 service rates. Transmittal 39 is scheduled to become effective on April 19, 2003.

With this application, NBTC requests permission to waive Sections 61.58 and 61.59 of the Commission's Rules in order to withdraw, without becoming effective, the tariff material originally filed under Transmittal No. 39. NBTC wishes to restore currently effective material and to withdraw tariff material filed under Transmittal No. 39 without becoming effective in order to further assess the proposed tariff revisions. Illustrative tariff pages are attached.

A waiver of Section 61.58 is requested to permit the revision of tariff material to become effective on not less than 1 day's notice. A waiver of Section 61.59 is requested to permit revisions to tariff material that has not yet become effective.

This Application letter and the appropriate illustrative tariff pages are being filed electronically today via the Federal Communications Commission's Electronic Tariff Filing System (ETFS).

Payment in the amount of \$695.00 has been electronically transmitted to the Mellon Bank in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, in accordance with the fee program procedures. The Form 159 is being transmitted electronically via ETFS as a proprietary document. These actions have been committed on the date established as the issued (filed) date as reflected above.
