This filing is being made on 15 days' notice under the Federal Communications Commission's streamlined filing procedure, and proposes the following revisions to Tariff F.C.C. No. 3:

- 1) Addition of rates for the provision of Digital Subscriber Line (DSL) Technology in the states of Nebraska and Wyoming;
- 2) Addition of rates to expand the provision of Asynchronous Transfer Mode (ATM) service in Sprint LTC's Midwest jurisdiction to include customers in the states of Nebraska and Wyoming;
- 3) Addition of rates for the provision of Single-Pair High-Speed Digital Subscriber Line (SHDSL) service in the states of Minnesota, New Jersey, Tennessee and Virginia;
- 4) Addition of special construction charges for the installation of fiber optic facilities designed to meet the specific requirements of customers in the states of Indiana, North Carolina and Ohio;
- 5) Addition of rates and regulations for the provision of Ordering Options, Additional Labor and Miscellaneous Services associated with switched dedicated and special access services provided in the metropolitan statistical areas (MSAs) where pricing flexibility has been granted;

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- 6) Addition of tariff language allowing Sprint SONET Ring ServiceSM customers the option of discontinuing their service, without incurring termination liability charges, if Sprint LTC elects to increase Sprint SONET Ring ServiceSM rates; and
- 7) Minor tariff language changes designed to clarify the provision of interstate access services.

Cost support material in accordance with Sections 61.38 and 61.41 through 61.49 of the Commission's Rules is provided, where required, for this filing
