

**Sprint Local Telephone Companies**

***Description and Justification***

The Sprint local telephone companies (Sprint LTC) hereby submit the following information in support of the accompanying tariff filing, as required by Sections 61.38 and 61.41 through 61.49 of the Federal Communications Commission's Rules and Regulations.

This filing is being made on 15 days' notice under the Federal Communications Commission's streamlined filing procedures, and introduces a promotional offering waiving the first month's recurring charge, and providing an additional one month recurring charge credit on the anniversary date of each year of the term, for Sprint Custom Access Solutions<sup>SM</sup> arrangements ordered under a one, two or three year minimum service period from May 19, 2003 through November 30, 2003.

***1.0 Sprint Custom Access Solutions<sup>SM</sup> Promotion***

In order to stimulate the sale of Sprint Custom Access Solutions<sup>SM</sup> (SCAS) arrangements, Sprint LTC is introducing a limited time promotional offering whereby the first month's recurring charges associated with SCAS will be waived for customers who install a new SCAS arrangement under a one, two or three year minimum service period. In addition, the customer will receive a credit equal to one month's recurring charges on the anniversary date of the installation of the SCAS arrangement for the duration of the minimum service period. To be eligible for this promotional offering, customers must place the order for SCAS from May 19, 2003 through November 30, 2003. In the event the customer terminates its SCAS arrangement prior to the expiration date of the minimum service period,

any monthly recurring charges waived or credited under this promotion will be included in the calculation of the customer's termination liability charges.

## ***2.0 Conclusion***

The Sprint local telephone companies are submitting the accompanying tariff revisions in response to customer requests for the proposed services, and in accordance with the Commission's Rules governing the provision of interstate access services.
