Application is hereby made by BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc, (hereinafter BellSouth), for Special Permission to waive Sections 61.58 and 61.59 of the Commission's Rules in order to revise material filed under Transmittal No. 716.

On April 25, 2003, in Transmittal 716, BellSouth made a tariff filing in Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, to restructure ordering charges associated with service orders and to introduce a Service Date Advancement-Missed Appointment Charge that would apply when a customer is not ready to accept the service.

With this application, BellSouth wishes to further clarify the application of certain charges associated with ordering access services. A waiver of Sections 61.58 and 61.59 is requested to revise material that has not yet become effective and to allow those revisions to become effective on May 10, 2003, the same scheduled effective date as the material originally filed under Transmittal No. 716.
