The accompanying tariff material, issued by the Verizon Telephone Companies (Verizon) and bearing Tariff FCC No. 1, Tariff FCC No. 11, Tariff FCC No. 14, Access Service, and Tariff FCC No. 21, Special Construction are sent to you for filing in compliance with the requirements of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended. This material, filed on fifteen days' notice and scheduled to become effective May 28, 2003, consists of tariff pages as indicated on the following check sheets:

1. On March 14, 2003, under Transmittal No. 301, Verizon filed modifications to a specialized arrangement for the Bank of New York in both Tariff FCC Nos. 1 and 11. A typographical error was inadvertently made on the USOC included with that filing. Verizon is correcting the USOC with this filing.

Supporting material as described under Section 61.38 of Commission's Rules is not required with this filing.

2. On January 15, 2003, under Transmittal No. 279, Verizon filed two specialized arrangements in Tariff FCC No. 14. An error was inadvertently made in the dates for the beginning of the Termination Liability Period. Verizon is correcting these dates with this filing. Additionally, this filing is removing a USOC code that is no longer required so that it may be reused for another specialized arrangement at a later date.

Supporting material as described under Section 61.38 of Commission's Rules is not required with this filing.

3. This filing also provides for Special Construction of facilities to provision tariffed services in FCC 21 for the following: New York – Sotheby Parke Bernet, Inc., Morgan Stanley, and New York City DOITT; Maryland – National Association of Securities Dealers; California – AT&T, and Sprint PCS; Washington – AT&T; Florida – Sprint Communications; Hawaii – Verizon Wireless. ICBs are being terminated for Texas due to the customer canceling the service, and Michigan due to customer canceling after signed contract. Florida also shows a deletion of an ICB that was terminated before the page was grandfathered, the correction to that section is shown with this filing. Administrative changes are also being made with this filing.

Supporting material as specified under Section 61.49 of the Commission's Rules is included with this filing.

This transmittal letter and associated attachments are being filed electronically today via the Federal Communications Commission's Electronic Tariff Filing System (ETFS).
