RE: 2003 Price Cap Revisions Errata Filing

On May 1, 2003, Ameritech Operating Companies (Ameritech) submitted a letter filing to provide revised Price Cap Indices (PCIs) for each basket of services in preparation for the 2003 Annual Tariff Filing to be submitted June 16, 2003. This errata letter filing includes the following modifications:

- A revised Telecommunications Relay Service (TRS) exogenous amount to reflect the recently proposed TRS factor,
- Revised TRS and Regulatory Fee obligations to ensure the Interstate End User Revenue base used to develop the obligation includes revenue collected for Universal Service Fund (USF) surcharges consistent with the FCC's Form 159,
- Revised exogenous amounts and revenue levels to reflect pricing flexibility petition approval received May 15, 2003.

This letter is filed in compliance with Order DA 03-1175, In the Matter of July 1, 2003 Annual Access Charge Tariff Filings, released April 18, 2003 and Order DA 03-1176, In the Matter of Material to be Filed in Support of 2003 Annual Access Tariff Filings, released April 18, 2003.
