(3) When a DA call is not completed due to the failure of Directory Access Service to DA locations, DA access equipment or DA operator activities, a credit allowance for the Switched Access Service portion in the originating LATA of such DA call will apply. When the customer reports such a call and DA number dialed, time of the call and the date of the call, the number of calls for which a credit will apply will be developed by the Telephone Company in cooperation with the customer. The credit will be as set forth following:

a) Credit per call when Switched Access Service is billed using Transitional per minute rates \$0.001956(I)

b) Credit per call when an Access Line Arrangement or Feature Group A and/or an Access Trunk Arrangement 950 or Feature Group B Switched Access Service is billed using Premium per minute rates \$0.002258(R)

c) Credit per call when an Access Trunk Arrangement NEA or Feature Group C and/or Access Trunk Arrangement 101XXXX or Feature Group D Switched Access Service is billed using Premium per minute rates \$0.002258(R)

(4) Credit allowances for other service interruptions will be provided as set forth in 2.4.4 preceding.

9.5 Rate Regulations

A call is a call which has been answered by a DA operator. The charge applies whether or not the DA operator provides the requested telephone number. A credit for the provision of an incorrect telephone number will be applied as set forth in 9.4(G) preceding.
