The accompanying interstate access service tariff issued by Shell Rock Telephone Company and bearing Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 is sent to you for filing in compliance with the requirements of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended.

Effective July 1, 2003, Supplement No. 2 cancels in its entirety Shell Rock Telephone Company's Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 offering interstate access services. Instead of issuing and maintaining its own tariff for interstate access services, Shell Rock Telephone will thereafter be a participating carrier in the National Exchange Carrier Association ("NECA") Tariff F.C.C. No. 5. The rates, terms and conditions of Shell Rock Telephone Company, Inc.'s interstate access tariff will thereafter be found in the NECA tariff.
