Dear Ms. Dortch:

The accompanying tariff materials issued by Alliance Communications Cooperative, Inc. (Alliance) (FRN #0005-0971-59), and bearing F.C.C. No. 1 and No. 2, effective July 1, 2003, are sent to you in compliance with the Communications Act of 1934, as amended and pursuant to the Commission's Rules. Alliance is a Subset 3 carrier with 50,000 or fewer access lines and, therefore, is submitting this filing pursuant to Section 61.39 of the Commission's Rules. Alliance is not including any additional uncollectibles resulting from interexchange carrier or competitive local exchange carrier bankruptcies in its revenue requirements or rates at this time, and therefore this tariff filing is accompanied by neither Section 61.38 cost support nor a Tariff Review Plan.

The purposes of this filing are to: (1) submit revised traffic sensitive access rates for Alliance's Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, which applies to Alliance's Study Area No. 391657 (formerly operated under the name of Splitrock Telecom Cooperative, Inc.); (2) submit new traffic sensitive access service regulations, rates and charges in Alliance Tariff F.C.C. No. 2, which applies to Alliance's Study Area No. 391642 (formerly operated under the name of Baltic Telecom Cooperative, Inc. and East Plains Telecom, Inc.); and (3) revise the Title Page of Alliance's Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 to indicate that the regulations, rates and charges for Alliance's Study Area No. 391642 are now found in Alliance's Tariff F.C.C. No. 2 rather than National Exchange Carrier Association Tariff F.C.C. No. 5.
